7. AGR3006/01 - PROHIBITION OF DRIVING TRAFFIC ORDER - PART OF BRICKLEY LANE, DEVIZES

Wiltshire Council are writing as part of the pre-consultation process in relation to the proposed prohibition of driving along the southern part of Brickley Lane, Devizes.

The attached plan demonstrates the exact area concerned (doc 7/1).

As part of the new estate construction the lower part of Brickley Lane was closed to motorised vehicles and bollarded off at North and South ends. It is the intention of this Traffic Order to formalise the restriction.

There will be following a formal and full consultation at a later date however Wiltshire Council are seeking members opinions at this stage.

8. REPORT FOR INFORMATION – DYING HORSE CHESTNUT TREE, 7 HENMAN CLOSE

Proposed works to a dying Horse Chestnut tree are considered exempt from the formal notification process and it may be removed at the applicant's earliest convenience, subject to the planting of a replacement tree within the immediate vicinity.
