7. REPORT FOR INFORMATION - THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (DEVIZES) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, TAXI RANK CLEARWAYS AND ON STREET PARKING) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2009 (AMENDMENT NO.9) ORDER 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 8th August 2017 Wiltshire Council made the above mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 to amend the following restrictions in the Devizes Consolidation Order 2009 by revoking Map Schedule No EH53 dated 4th December 2009 and replacing it by the insertion of revised Map Schedule No EH53 the effect of which will be to extend existing **No Waiting at any time** on the following length of road:

Avon Road – east side – from a point 27 metres south of its junction with Bath Road for a distance of 29 metres in a south then easterly direction.

A copy of the Order and plan may be inspected at the offices of Wiltshire Council, County Hall, Bythesea Road, Trowbridge during normal office hours.

8. REPORT FOR DECISION – URGENT CLOSURE OF A361 ESTCOURT STREET (PART), DEVIZES

Wiltshire Council hereby give notice that on 07 September 2017, the following length of road shall be closed to all traffic in the interests of public safety to enable Wiltshire Council to carry out carriageway resurfacing and associated maintenance works.

A361 Estcourt Street (part), Devizes; from its junction with Southbroom Road to approximately public house The Bell By The Green.

Alternative route: Via A361 - A4 – A3102 – A342 – A361 and vice versa.

These works will commence on 07 September 2017 and are anticipated to be required for 2 nights between 19:00 and 00:00. This Notice will have a maximum duration of 21 days.
