7. REPORT FOR INFORMATION - PEDESTRIAN CROSSING REPLACEMENT - ESTCOURT STREET

Officers have received notification from Wiltshire Council that the existing pedestrian crossing located outside on The Bell By The Green has been in operation for a considerable period of time now and as part of a routine inspection it was highlighted that it was at high risk of suffering a terminal failure due to the age of the installation and condition of the equipment. We are informed by Wiltshire Council that their contractor Atkins, have undertaken a design to replace the existing Pelican crossing with a Puffin Crossing.

The design has now been completed and works are programmed to undertake the alterations from the 8th January 2018. In conjunction with the replacement of the crossing, work will also be undertaken to improve the carriageway surface in the immediate vicinity of the crossing.


Given the nature of the work required, the contractor will be utilising temporary traffic management to undertake certain elements. The contractor is currently working on a programme and traffic management plan for vehicles and pedestrians, and will make every effort to ensure the resultant inconvenience is minimised during this period. The works are currently programmed for a 4 week period.

For member's information, Puffin crossings are almost like Pelican crossing, but a little bit more intelligent. A Puffin crossing has sensors which detect the presence of a pedestrian and the signals for pedestrians are mounted on the near road side.
